<p>This is the ILTEA B1 English Listening Test. There are four parts to the test.</p>	
<p>Part 1</p>	
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>Look at the instructions for Part One. <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i> You will hear seven short conversations. You will hear each recording twice. For questions 1 to 7, choose one answer for each question. Here is an example:</p>
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>What day is it?</p>
<p>Woman</p>	<p>John, what's the date today?</p>
<p>Man</p>	<p>It's Friday, May 17th, today.</p>
<p>Woman</p>	<p>Right, thanks.</p>
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>The answer is A, so there is a mark on answer sheet A. Now we are ready to start. Look at question one. <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i></p>
<p>Question 1</p>	
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>One. What time will the train leave?</p>
<p>Woman</p>	<p>This is an announcement for all passengers on the 9:45 train to Toronto, stopping at Brantford and Oshawa. We regret that due to heavy snow on the tracks there will be a one hour delay. The new departure time will be 10:45. Please remain in the lounge until you are called. Thank you.</p>
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>Now listen again. (repeat) <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i></p>
<p>Question 2</p>	
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>Two. Which is the photo of the girl's mother?</p>
<p>Woman</p>	<p>Have I shown you this beautiful old photo of my mother I found in the garret?</p>
<p>Man</p>	<p>No, let me see. Gee! She was really pretty.</p>
<p>Woman</p>	<p>Yes, she was. Of course, she was much younger then and she didn't wear glasses.</p>
<p>Voice-Over</p>	<p>Now listen again. (repeat)</p>

Question 3 Voice-Over	Three. What must the man wear for work?
Man	I must be dressed very formally for work. Always a suit with a neck tie, even if I work on Saturday. I don't like it, but my boss demands it.
Voice-Over	Now listen again. (repeat) <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i>
Question 4 Voice-Over	Four. Where will they sit in the park?
Man	Where shall we sit to eat our picnic? On that bench by the pond?
Woman	No, there's no shade over there and I'm getting really hot.
Man	Okay, then let's sit on the bench over there, by the big tree.
Woman	Yes, that'll be nice.
Voice-Over	Now listen again. (repeat) <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i>
Question 5 Voice-Over	Five. What did the man forget?
Woman	Are you ready to go?
Man	Yes, I just think I've forgotten something? But what was it?
Woman	Do you have your glasses and your wallet?
Man	Yes, I have my wallet, and I'm wearing my glasses, but...oh, the keys, that's what I forgot!
Voice-Over	Now listen again. (repeat) <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i>
Question 6 Voice-Over	Six. Where is the woman going?
Woman	I'm just going out to get a cake to have for dessert tonight. Do you want anything?
Man	Yes, if you are going to the grocer's you can get me some apples.
Woman	Oh, well, I'm just going to the bakery around the corner.
Man	That's okay, I can get some apples for myself later.

Question 7 Voice-Over	Seven. Where is the magazine?
Man	Have you seen my magazine? I left it on the table next to the TV, but now I can't find it.
Woman	Did you look under the TV?
Man	No, I didn't look there, but, oh, here it is under the table.
Voice-Over	Now listen again. (repeat) That is the end of Part One. Now look at Part Two. <i>(pause 2 seconds)</i>
Part 2 Voice-Over	Part Two. Look at the questions for this part. You will hear a tour guide telling a tour group about a day trip in the Blue Mountains. For questions 8 to 13, choose a correct answer for each question. You will hear the recording twice. Now, you have 20 seconds to look at questions 8 to 13. <i>(pause 20 seconds)</i> Now listen carefully.
